

Chinese Coins-A Beginner Quilt

2-day workshop

Finished quilt is 21" x 21"

Supply List



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Fabrics:

Note: This little quilt is made using a single colour family. Find a few variations in your favourite colour family -making sure you have lights and darks. (11 different fabrics were used in the yellow Chinese Coins quilt, plus a border fabric). A suggestion -buy .1 m (4") of six different lights and .1 m (4") of six different darks. You will then have plenty to choose from.

- .5 m TOTAL assorted dark fabrics in your favourite colour
- .5 m TOTAL assorted light fabrics in your favourite colour
- .75 meter fabric for border
- (Border fabric suggestions: Recommended- an all over print is good, a print that has close values –all over medium or dark- is good, Not recommended- one-way stripes or directional prints, fabrics that are very light/white with dark motifs)
- .25 meter of fabric for binding
- .75 meter fabric for the back of the quilt
- 25" square cotton type batting such as Hobbs Heirloom Premium–*polyester batting is NOT recommended*
- cotton threads for quilting- colour should match or be close in colour to top fabrics (can be chosen in Class #2)
- You will need a washable/removable quilt marker of some kind -chalk, or something that will be visible on your border fabric

Tools:

- Sewing machine **and** the manual for it if you have it
- Regular presser foot, quarter-inch foot and walking foot for the sewing machine
- Sewing machine needles, size #70 or #80 Universal **or** Jeans/Denim (*the size "# is the important thing*), don't bring large needles (100 or 110 are large)
- Scissors, **fine** glass-head pins, a seam ripper and pin cushion
- Hand sewing needle- a fairly fine one (needed for Class 4)
- masking tape
- 100% cotton thread (medium to light gray is a good colour to blend with most fabric colours).
- Rotary cutting equipment: mat (at least 17" x 23"), cutter with NEW blade, and rulers- 6" square, 12½" square and a 6" x 24".
- Safety pins for pin basting – you will need 25 or so- the coloured ones in a package are great
- Large "zip-lock" type bag to keep track of cut pieces between classes
