## Supply List

### Fabrics and other soft stuff:

- ◆ 2 groups of four fat quarters in fabrics that you like together -these can be colour related or different colours. You should have some variation in value in each group of four- lights, mediums and darks.
- ◆ Extra fabric for possible borders to go with either (or both) groups.
- ◆ Various threads for piecing and topstitching, including nylon or polyester monofilament to match and contrast your fabrics.
- ◆ Batting -a minimum of 30” square, but don't cut a big piece up to bring it.
- ◆ Backing fabric- we may get to the quilting stage!

### Machine and other hard stuff:

- ◆ machine capable of zigzag stitch and blanket stitch
- ◆ regular presser foot as well as open toe presser foot
- ◆ walking foot and free motion presser foot
- ◆ rotary cutter and mat and rulers (6” x 24” and -optional 12 ½” or 15” square)
- ◆ seam ripper, pins, scissors (include paper scissors if you wish)
- ◆ safety pins for basting -to machine quilt (optional- see above)
- ◆ masking tape
- ◆ freezer paper
- ◆ glue stick or basting glue
- ◆ fusible web of your choice (small amount) and pressing sheet to save ironing board
- ◆ paper towel, tracing paper or other stabilizer
- ◆ chalk marker or other removable marker
- ◆ large eye hand sewing needle for burying thread tails
- ◆ (optional) digital camera
