

## Sliced Circles

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Play with great fabrics and circles and parts of circles. Arrange and shuffle the pieces into a wonderful exploration of the fascinating circle.

### Supply List

- 8- 12 fat quarters of fabric- lights, mediums and darks (*or larger pieces- don't specially cut them into fat quarters, you may not use them all but you must have some with you to make choices*)
- possible fabrics for borders- at least 2 half-meter pieces to choose from
- Sewing machine with regular presser foot, ¼ inch foot and open toe foot if you have one (machine should have zigzag capability)
- machine needles (*size # 70 or # 80 Jeans/Denim or Universal*)
- Pins, seam ripper
- Pencil and scissors for fabric and for paper
- Rotary cutting equipment- mat, cutter. *Please make sure you have a sharp blade in your cutter!*
- Large 15" square ruler and long ruler (6" x 24")
- Freezer paper and glue stick or spray starch and small brush
- Invisible polyester or fine nylon sewing thread
- Thread for piecing- when in doubt about colour, medium gray usually works well with most fabric colours
- Iron and board or pad
- Design wall or piece of cotton-type batting to pin to wall
- Paper or notepad
- Digital camera
